Student instruction at the Career Center will be in-person during Phase 4. Students will need to attend on the same days in-person instruction is offered at their sending school regardless of the learning option they choose. Students are encouraged to attend on the other days that their sending schools are not in session. Local districts will be providing transportation.



The health and safety of students and staff are our top priority.

The Career Center will follow the required & recommended safety protocols put forth in Michigan's Return to School Roadmap. That includes wearing masks, requiring proper hygiene, temperature screening, implementing strict cleaning procedures and maintaining a safe distance between people as much as possible.



Guidance regarding symptomatic individuals will be followed.

The Career Center will cooperate with the Jackson County Health Department in regards to what protocols need to be followed if a student or staff member shows symptoms of COVID-19 or has tested positive for COVID-19.
