Dear Parents/Guardians and Students:

Many Jackson County school employees have begun the process of voluntarily receiving the COVID-19 vaccine. JCISD staff were given the opportunity to have the first dose of the vaccine on January 13th and 14th. The second dose will be offered to our staff on February 3rd and 4th. Medical staff have warned us that side effects from the second dose are more likely to include some sickness (headache, muscle ache, fever).
