- 1. We have just developed assessments specific for our populations (severely cognitively, severely multiply impaired and autistic).
- 2. We developed outcome indicators in the areas of ELA, math and science.
- 3. Much of what we do is based on the disability of our students regarding analysis of writing, reading, science, math, and social studies.
- 4. We are continuing to work on the analysis of writing, reading, science, math and social studies.
- 5. We are just starting to look at the student achievement data.
- 6. We will continue to make changes to ensure our students are progressing academically.
- 7. School is showing improvement in Math and ELA
- 8. We are continuing to look at the grade level achievement data.
- 9. We are continuing to address our assessments, extended grade level content expectations.
- 10. All of the areas are a challenge. We are a center base program with medically fragile, severely multiply impaired, severely cognitively impaired and autistic students. We strive to make sure our students receive the same educational opportunities as their peers.
