ABC Humane Wildlife Control & Prevention, Inc. Academic Scholarship

Eligibility:

To apply for the scholarship, applicant must be:

- a student currently enrolled at a college or university recognized by the U.S. Department of Education in the United States.
- studying or planning to study the fields of science (excluding social sciences i.e., economics), engineering, mathematics, or technology.
- a person who identifies as female

If the applicant or the applicant's parent/legal guardian is employed by ABC Wildlife, Inc. at the time of award, the student is not eligible for the scholarship. Eligibility of finalists will be verified before winners are selected.

Applicant must include "Women in STEM Scholarship" in the subject line of the submission email. (submission to be sent to: grants@abcwildlife.com)

2022 Platt Family Scholarship Prize Essay Contest

Eligibility:

- The scholarship essay contest is designed for students who are **full-time**, undergraduate students attending an **American college or university** during the Spring 2022 semester. The July 31 deadline is designed to give these students time to finish their essays, if necessary, after final exams.
- You do not have to be an American citizen, but you do need to be attending an American college or university during the eligibility period.
- **The scholarship is not open to high school students.** Key question to consider; when we contact your college or university registrar will they be able to confirm that you were enrolled as a full-time college student during the Spring 2022 semester? If the answer is no, you are not eligible.
- The eligibility of entrants will be confirmed by the Lincoln Forum prior to the awarding of prizes.
- Entries will be judged by the essay committee of The Lincoln Forum.

Description:

Our Topic for 2022:

The year 2022 is the anniversary of the dedication of the Lincoln Memorial. How has the whole question of memorializing leading figures of the Civil War, including Lincoln, changed in the hundred years since then?

- Entries must contain a minimum of 1,500 and a maximum of 5,000 words.
- The essay must be typed and include a works-cited page or bibliography. End notes are suggested but not required.

2022 NBCC Foundation Military Scholarships

Eligibility:

- Applicants must be enrolled, full time in a CACREP-accredited counseling master's program.
- Applicants must be veterans or active-duty U.S. military service members or spouses of a veteran or active-duty U.S. military service member. Veterans must have received an honorable discharge.
- Applicants must be currently enrolled full time for the fall 2022 semester and be in good standing in a CACREP-accredited counseling master's-level program. Applicants must have taken courses during the spring 2022 semester. Applicants may not have a pending status, deferred status, or other future start date for coursework.
- Applicants are expected to graduate by December 31, 2025
- Eligible applicants must not have an anticipated program completion date before September 1, 2023, which will be verified in writing by their academic department.
- Applicants must demonstrate knowledge of and experience with military personnel and families.
- Applicants must commit to becoming board certified by applying for the National Certified Counselor (NCC) certification prior to graduation and to completing the application process.

- Applicants must commit to providing mental health services to service members and/or veterans within one year of graduation and for the duration of a minimum of at least two years post-graduation.

Description:

These scholarships provide financial support to students who are currently enrolled in a Council for Accreditation of Counseling and Related Educational Programs (CACREP)-accredited counseling master's program, live in a rural area, and commit to serve rural populations within one year of graduation for the duration of a minimum of at least two years post-graduation.

Award: Five scholarships in the amount of \$8,000 are available.

- Either you or a close family member has been diagnosed with a form of autism, including Asperger syndrome, and
- Applicant must be an enrolled student at an accredited college, university, or vocational school, or be accepted to begin school at an accredited college, university, or vocational school in the semester for which the application is being offered.
- Additionally, applicants should submit an essay on one of the topics listed below with a minimum of 500 words and maximum of 1,000 words.
 1. Tell us about a time that you have had to overcome an obstacle as a person with autism that other people would not have had to face.
 2. Explain how your loved one's autism has affected you and how you have adapted to help them.
 3. Answer this question: What do you feel is the biggest obstacle holding back people with autism today?

Description:

The Perceman Firm, P.L.L.C. was touched by the story of 14-year-old Avonte Oquendo, an autistic boy who went missing after he wandered away from school in 2013. The outpouring of support and assistance that accompanied the search for Avonte was unprecedented. Although Avonte tragically did not make it home alive, we want to show the same support for the autistic community in memory of this extraordinary young man.
